Royal Organics has successfully created an innovative solution for placing compost through your no-till drill while seeding.

CompellTM efficiently adds organic matter, microbiology, carbon, and trace nutrients into the seed zone.

These components balance out the soil's diet and enable the crop to uptake nutrients, water, and defend itself better leading to increasing yield and profit.

Compell is a small, dry, compressed pellet (no manures or biosolids) that can be placed in the dry fertilizer hopper, or mixed with seed, and run through the drill at planting.

By concentrating on the seed zone, rather than the entire soil profile, only 40 lbs/acre of Compell is needed in most grain and oilseed applications.

A grower can expect a full application for around \$12 to \$15 per acre, with no specialized equipment.

Years of research and development, combined with field trials under the direction of Dr. Jill Clapperton, show 15-20% yield increases in wheat, and more in other grains and oilseeds.

Recent field surveys show increased wheat head counts, increased root mass, and better plant health. Growers planted approximately 15,000 acres with Compell in the Northwest, Midwest and Canada for the 2016 crop year. Several distributors, like Green Cover Seed, are now making it available to their growers.

HARD SPRING CONDITIONS The mild winter experienced in WA, ID, OR & ND made for dry spring seeding conditions.

WINTER WHEAT CROPS

Mild winter conditions have made for good looking winter wheat crops in the Palouse and Idaho.

The wet and warm conditions have got the plants about 2-3 weeks ahead from a growth perspective. Heads were already forming in early May in St John WA. There was some concern regarding stripe rust and farmers were spraying for this.
