#### New Zealand & International Cross Slot drill owners tour the Pacific Northwest

Some 25 Cross Slot drill owners from Australia, Germany, Canada, USA and New Zealand arrived in Spokane in late June and joined together in an 8-day bus tour of the Palouse and surrounding area.

They were guests of several local Cross Slot and leading conservation tillage farmers in the Palouse and northern Oregon region.

Many of these owners and farmers produce excellent yields from their crops and are upset if they are not getting above average wheat returns per acre.

The tour highlighted the difference in management techniques used by the farmers to achieve these types of yields... especially as they felt the soils here are better with similar moisture levels.

### Cross Slot rapidly spreading beyond the PNW

Cross Slot has participated in several recent machinery fairs and field trials, including field trials at St John, WA; Cover crop field days in Kansas; Four States Farm Show in Kansas with local agent Storrer Implement and local owner Steve Frank; The "Big Iron Show" in Fargo, ND in October 2010 with local farmer and North Dakota Cross Slot product specialist Kevin Larson.

Cross Slot is working on getting new 45 foot designs into the North Dakota market and is currently working with Agpro to deliver a new 20 foot machine into Alaska.

#### Two new Custom Conservation No-Tillage Seeding Machines are now available

Dale Kopf of Moscow, ID began custom seeding with a 25 ft Agpro/Cross Slot drill fitted with openers on 10 inch spacing in Spring 2010. Jon Olson of Garfield purchased a similar Agpro/Cross Slot drill for September 2010 startup.

These 25 ft drills are self contained as wing-up frames, air seeders with liquid fertilizer banded on each opener. Safety monitors are included on seed, fertilizer and seed depth plus GPS for auto steer and mapping. These custom operators have seeded a wide variety of crops, soils, residues and topography with excellent success.

Over 6,000 acres in Washington, Oregon and Idaho have been drilled by Dale and Jon this year with very good results for guys who are learning a new system.

In particular, Dale drilled 160 acres of barley in late spring for Jon Olson using Cross Slot.Jon then drilled around 40 acres of barley alongside using his John Deere 455 for comparison. His test results showed a yield increase of 1,053 lbs (22 bushels) an acre for Cross Slot.

In fall seeding Jon drilled winter wheat into 440 acres of bluegrass take-out in Benewah County, ID. The bluegrass had been sprayed out leaving a heavy residue mass.

The farmer said "the resulting stand of wheat is the best you could possibly hope for. We are amazed. This stand is on our longest grass history, lowest Ph, all said 'worst' ground."
